Graveside services will be held at 10 a.m. Monday at West Hill Cemetery for Ray Ellis McClure, 48, retired Air Force master sergeant of 2305 Ridgewood, who died Thursday at a Lackland Air Force Base Hospital in San Antonio.

Services will be conducted by Johnny Richardson, Commander of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2772, with burial in the Veterans Section of West Hill Cemetery under the direction of Waldo Funeral Home.
