## **FOR YOUR INFORMATION**

This may or may not pertain to any of our group, but did you know, if a retired member engages in foreign employment for compensation without authorization, the member's retired pay becomes subject to a withholding and/or debt, generally in an amount equal to the total amounts received from the foreign government? According to 37 U.S.C. § 908, retirees who are considering accepting employment with a foreign government for compensation must first apply for and receive approval in advance from the Secretary of State and the Secretary of the Service from which the member retired must both approve the employment/ compensation.

## The 25th Reunion Guest Speaker

I had the distinct pleasure of inviting and introducing Mark Pestana, Colonel, USAF Reserve (ret) as our keynote speaker at our September 2022 reunion. Col Pestana served in the US Air Force and NASA as a pilot, and a space operations engineer. Mark is also an internationally award-

winning artist, specializing in landscape, seascape, and aerospace art. His paintings are in corporate, government, and private collections, and have flown into space. Fourteen of his paintings are displayed in the Pentagon collection. Colonel Pestana has the unique distinction of designing the following nine Space Shuttle mission patches for the astronauts.



When Life Support and Survival Equipment merged and became Aircrew Flight Equipment I wondered if the new career field would adopt a new logo. I was working in the NASA Dryden (now Armstrong) Flight Research Center's Life Support Systems Section at the time and thought it would be nice if I could get Mark who worked across the hall from me to design a new logo to represent the old and new career fields. Colonel Pestana gladly took on the challenge and came up with the following design.



To the Colonel's surprise I announced at the reunion that I had recently had the design made into the coin shown below. Both sides of the coin are the same with the exception of the

inscription. One side represents the old career field and has Aircrew Life Support stamped on it. The reverse side represents the new career field, Aircrew Flight Equipment, and is stamped as such. For accepting my invitation to be our guest speaker I presented one of the coins to the Colonel. Then I had the Colonel issue all the ALS/AFE reunion attendees one of the coins. As you can see each side of the coin represents both eras of the career field.
